Peter K. Butler, being first duly sworn on oath states as follows:

1. I am Peter K. Butler, a petitioner in above-captioned matter.
2. I reside at 2140 Bayard Avenue in the City of St. Paul.
3. I have not contracted for garbage service at my home since about 1995.
4. I compost food scraps on my property.

5. I recycle all recyclable materials through the City of St. Paul's recycling program and dispose of household hazardous waste at the Ramsey County Household Hazardous Waste Collection Site at 5 Empire Drive in the City of St Paul.

6. I produce one to two cereal-bags worth of garbage each week. The contents are all non-recyclable, non-compostable, inorganic materials, such as food wrappers, plastic bread bags, used paper towels and the like, that would never spoil if stored onsite in a container.


7. For the last decade or so, my neighbors at 2136 Bayard Avenue have allowed me to dispose of my household solid waste in their garbage container.

8. I have never used the City's mandatory trash program that began on October 1, 2018.

9. On September 29, 2018, I left my city-assigned garbage cart (#71863411) at the City of St. Paul's Department of Public Works facility at 891 Dale St. and have not had a cart since then.
